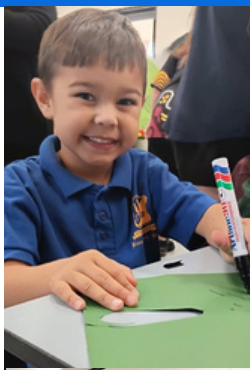

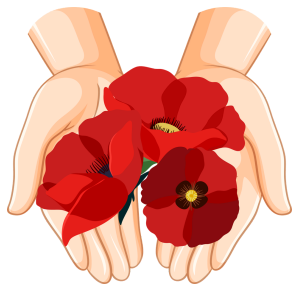
Where can you find out how heavy a whale is?

FUN LUNCHBOX BITES

Weet-Bix Slice

Ingredients

- 12 Weet-Bix
- ¼ cup cocoa powder
- ¾ cup brown sugar
- 200g butter
- ½ cup desiccated coconut
- 1 egg



Method

1. Preheat oven to 180 degrees celsius.
2. Finely crush the Weet-Bix.
3. Combine all ingredients in a bowl and mix well.
4. Press the mixture firmly into a baking paper lined cake or slice tin.
5. Bake for 15 to 20 minutes or until firm to the touch.
6. Allow to cool.
7. Top with icing or melted chocolate and sprinkles.

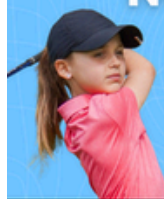
